EXCITING COMING EVENTS

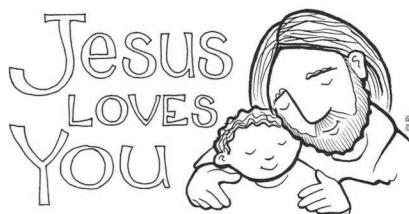
I just want to let you know about a couple of upcoming events so you will be sure to save time on your busy calendars.
