HOLY FAMILY 2012 -2013 Applications Available Beginning January 29th



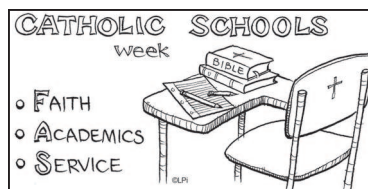

Hope Warming Center

It is time to begin the organization of our annual week at the **Hope Warming Center**, headquartered in Pontiac at **249 Baldwin**. This is an exciting year for the shelter because this address is the **new and permanent home of the Hope Center!** It is across the street from Baldwin Methodist Church where the shelter was housed for ten years.

Our week is **February 13-20, 2012** and as always, we welcome all of you to be part of this significant outreach to the homeless people in Pontiac. Perhaps a little background will encourage you to participate this year.

The Hope Warming Center began in 1999 because a group of Christian churches decided that it was absolutely necessary to get the homeless people in Pontiac off the streets during January, February and March. Baldwin Methodist Church offered their building for this purpose and the coalition of churches promised to provide a hot dinner and supervision every night for these three cold months.

That first year Sacred Heart actually signed up for two weeks! This turned out to be quite an endeavor and in subsequent years, we have volunteered for one week only. During our week in February, we need to provide and serve dinners for 40-45 guests and have volunteers, both male and female stay throughout the night for our seven nights.

A lot of you help out in September when we host the South Oakland Shelter group here on our campus. The Hope Warming Center differs in many ways from SOS in that Hope takes in anyone who is homeless, whereas a person has to qualify for the SOS program. The Hope Warming Center is a service to **the poorest of the poor, who have absolutely no place to go on the coldest nights of the year**. There are no mattresses for this program, only blankets and the floor. This is true street ministry and it is only happening because people like **YOU** get involved.

Our sign up sheets are now in the Gathering Space. There are opportunities to help with the meals, to provide necessary food items for the dinners and to be one of the on-site people. On-site duties include everything from working at the sign-in table, serving dinner, passing out blankets and staying overnight. So mark your calendars now and decide what part you will play in this much needed service project. Please search your heart and consider this opportunity for being God's Hands...and Heart to the poor.
