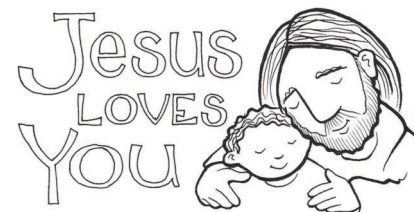

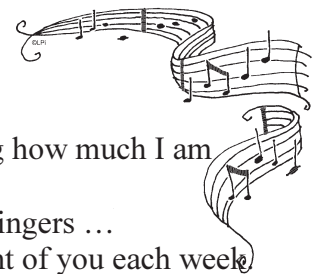

Greetings Everyone:

I want to start out my "*Musical Notes*" by saying how much I am enjoying working with you all at Sacred Heart. You are a great group ... and a great bunch of singers ... and I feel very privileged to be sitting up in front of you each week!

We sing a lot of different hymns at Mass, so I thought you might enjoy hearing a little bit about how and why some of these songs were written. A little background on this week's opening hymn follows:

"Praise the Lord, Ye Heavens"

Hymn # 554 in the *Breaking Bread* book

*"Praise the Lord! Ye heav'ns adore him;  
Praise him angels in the height  
Sun and moon, rejoice before him;  
Praise him all ye stars of light.*

One Sunday morning, Thomas Corin, retired from the Merchant Navy, found and abandoned baby on the steps of St. Andrew's Church in London. He and his wife took the baby home. Later, he discovered that there were many more abandoned children just like this one around the city. As a result, he established a Foundling Hospital. Eventually the hospital published its own collection of hymns, including this one. Based on Psalm 148, "Praise the Lord Ye Heavens" is another hymn composed around Beethoven's "*Hymn to Joy*".
