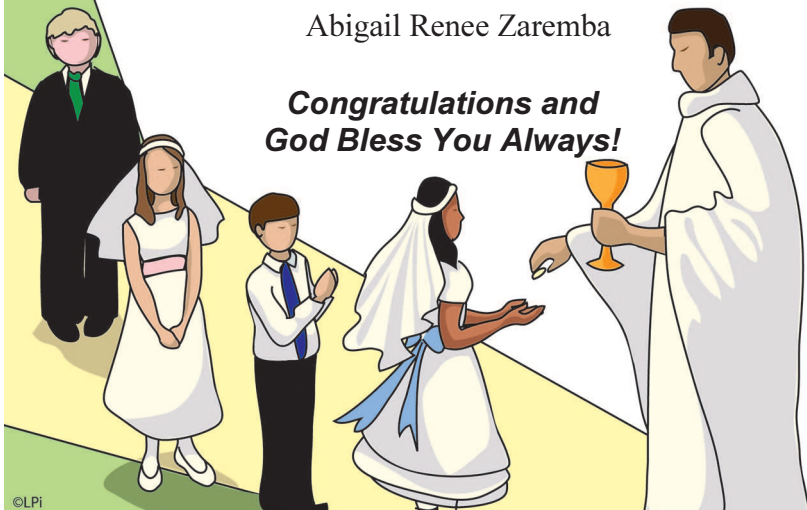

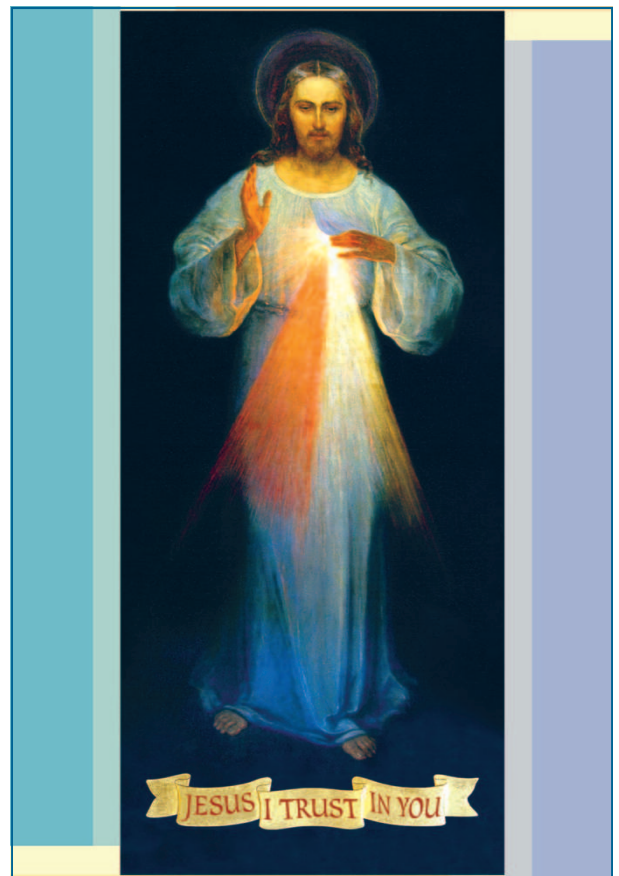

We are called to "act justly", Micah:6 - we can do this by taking the time to do the above to help alleviate suffering locally and beyond.
