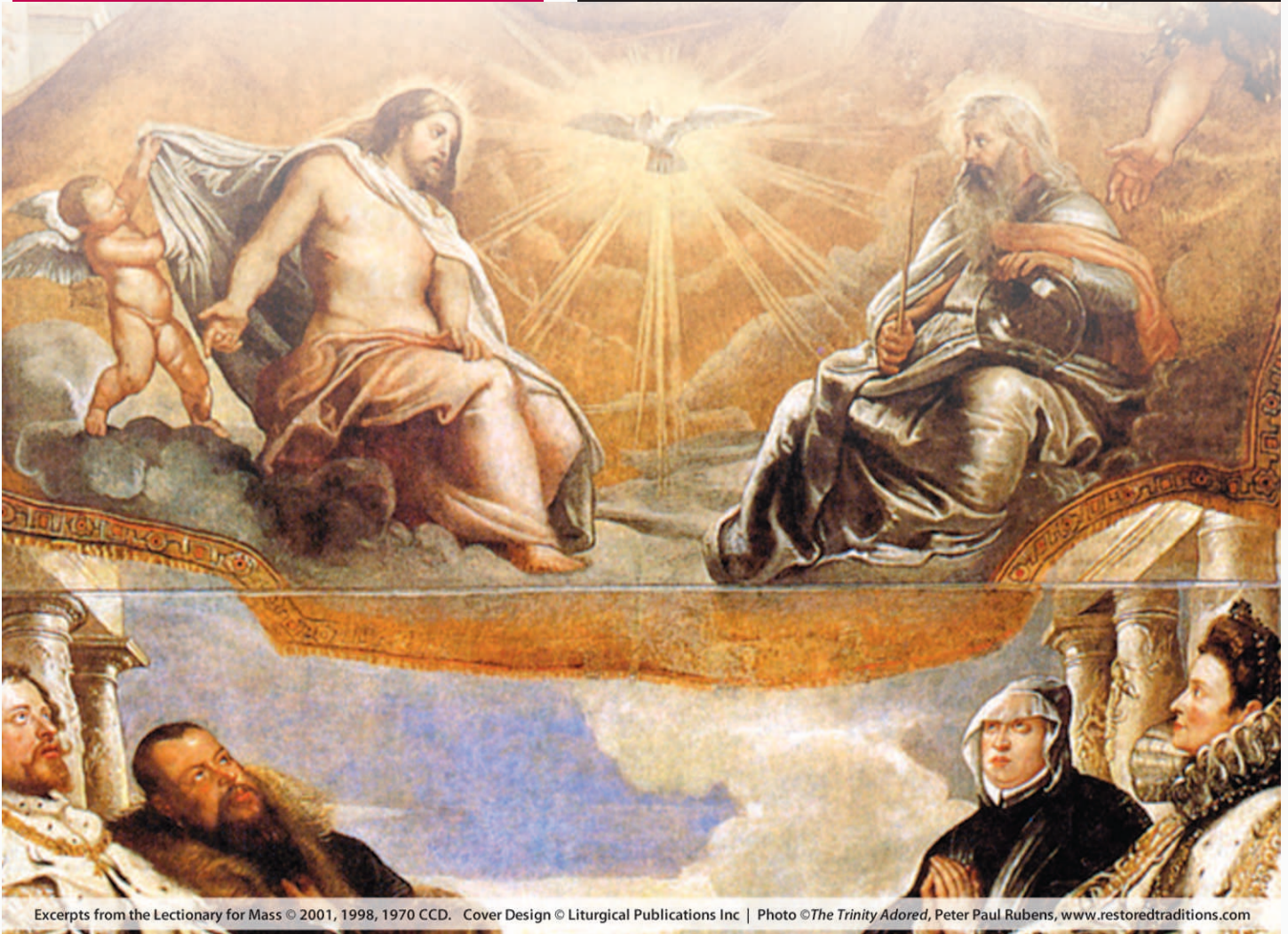

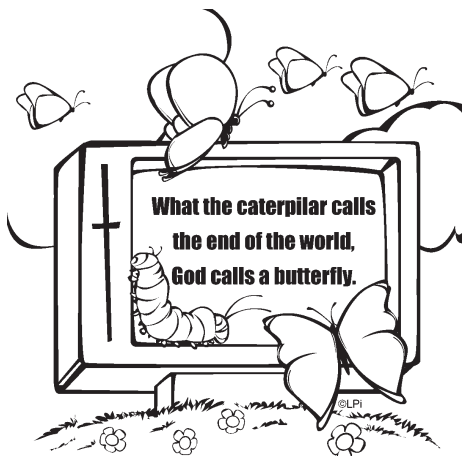

We celebrate Holy Trinity
Sunday today. Even the smartest
among us struggle to understand
this.

Q. Do we believe in one God or
in three Gods?

A. We believe in one God in
three persons. "God is not
solitude, but perfect
communion." (Pope Benedict
XVI). The word "Trinity" in
Latin is trinitas, and means
the state of being threefold. In
English we have two terms,
Triune God and the Trinity,
for the same reality. One
emphasizes God's unity, and
the other the distinction of
persons in him . . . an
indication that the Trinity is
an unfathomable mystery!
